The Coventry Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel a program due to insufficient registration, or any other cause, that prevents the presentation of an activity in an acceptable manner. REFUND POLICY

Participants will receive a refund when a program is cancelled due to lack of participants, facilities or qualified instruction. No refunds or prorating will be offered for classes missed by a participant for any reason.

All cash refunds will be issued in the form of a check. Refunds take approximately 3-4 weeks to be processed. Credit card payments will be refunded minus a 3% service charge. A \$26 service fee will be charged for any checks returned from the bank. Registrations are non-transferable.

Summer Camp Information

Who's Eligible? Youth in grades K-8 during the 2016/2017 school year

Camp Dates: July 5 – August 11, Monday-Friday

Camp Hours: 8:30am – 3:30pm

Extended Hours: \$60.00 per child: 8:00am – 4:30pm

Early drop off at 8:00am and late pick up by 4:30pm. The one-time fee covers all six weeks of camp.

Late Fees: \$5.00 per child every 10 minutes starting at 3:35pm; 4:35pm for those who have purchased the extended hours option. The late fee will be doubled after 3 occurrences of being late.

Camp Packet and T-Shirt Pickup: Saturday, June 10 from 8:30am-11:00am at the Guy L. Lefebvre Community Center

A valid ID is needed to pick up the camp packet and t-shirt. Answers to the most frequently asked questions, camp calendar with field trips listed, t-shirt, policies and other important information will be available.

If you're unable to come on this day you may come to the recreation office starting on June 12 from 8:30am-4:30pm.

Additional T-Shirt: \$5.00 each – limit one per child

You may purchase one additional t-shirt for \$5.00. Camp shirts must be worn on all field trips. No alterations to the t-shirt are allowed.
