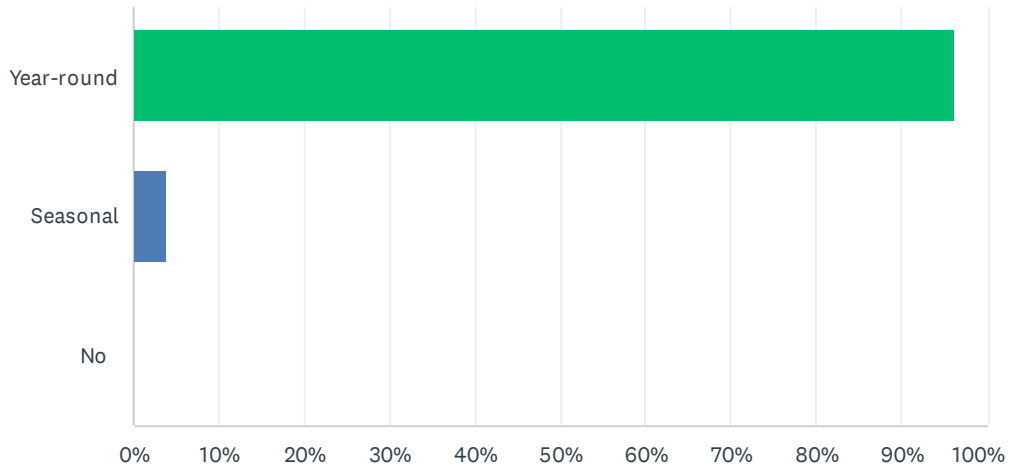

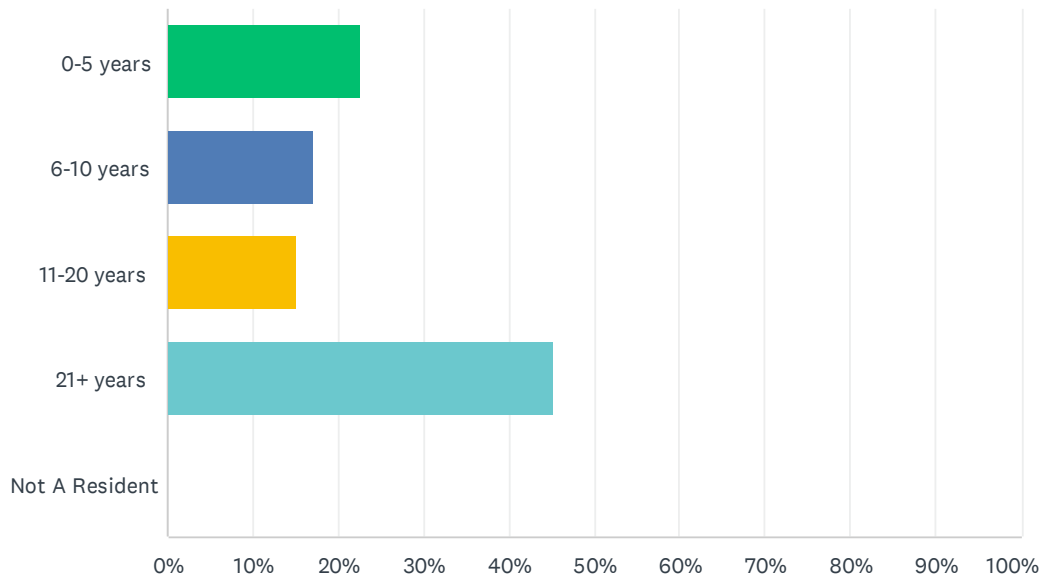

Q2 If you are a resident, how many years have you been a resident?

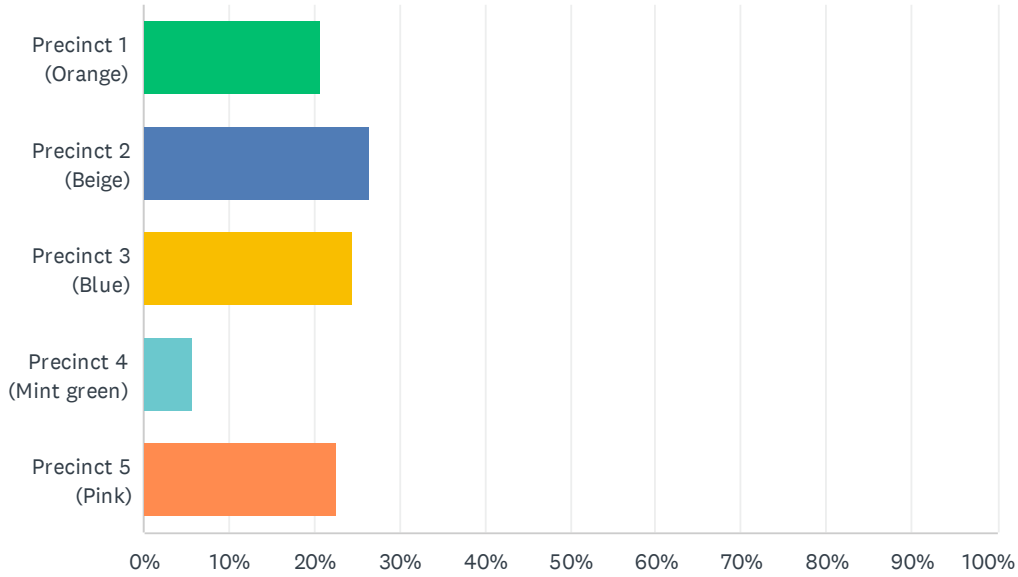

Q3 What area of town do you live in? (Select your voting precinct based on the map below)

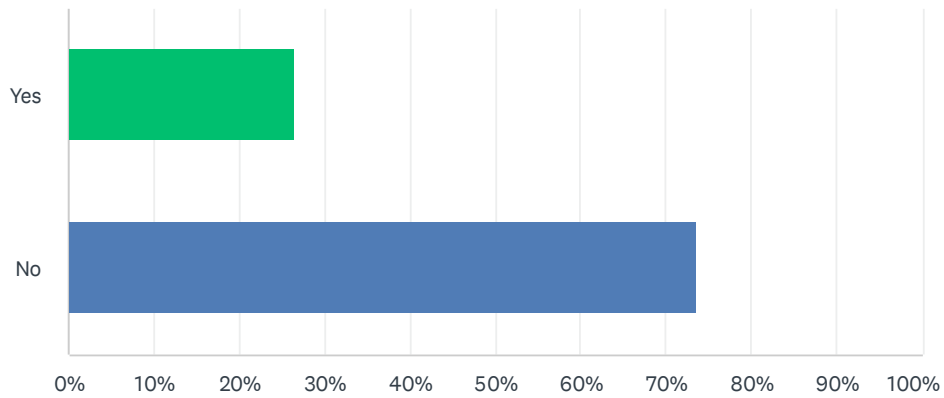

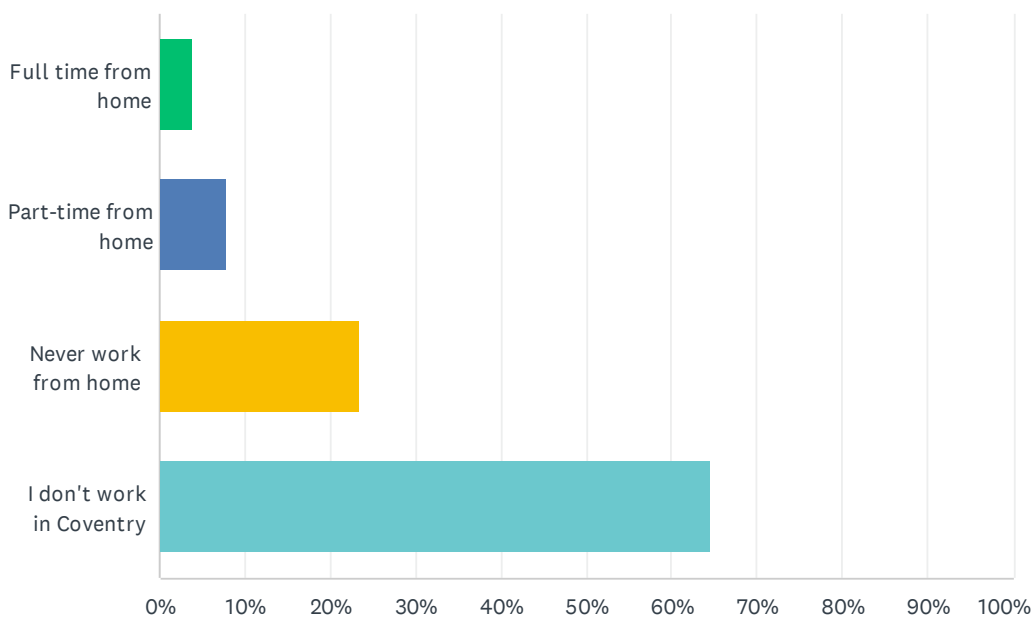

Q5 If you work in Coventry, do you work from home?

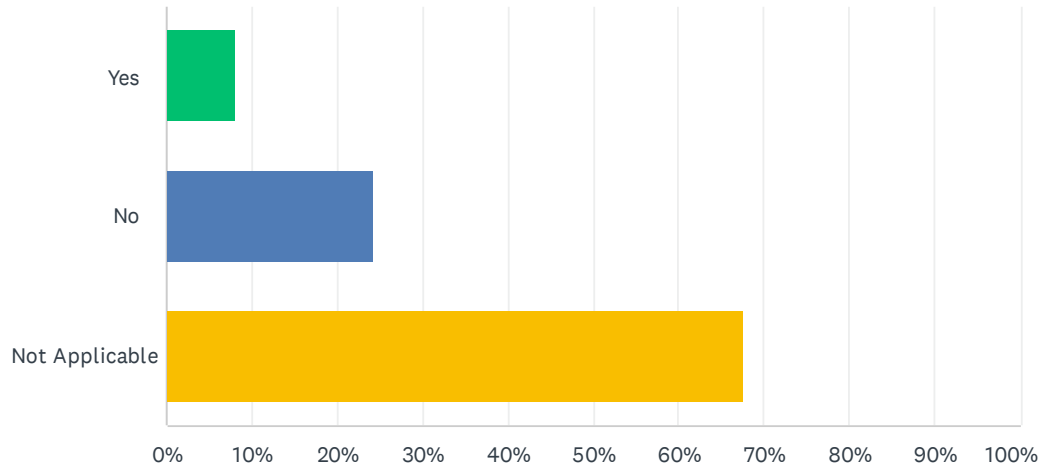

Q6 If you do work from home, did you work from home pre-COVID-19?

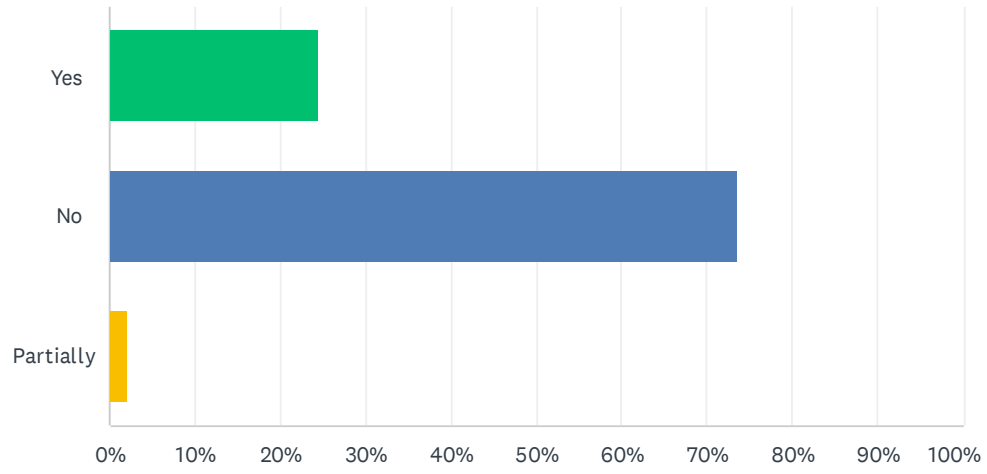

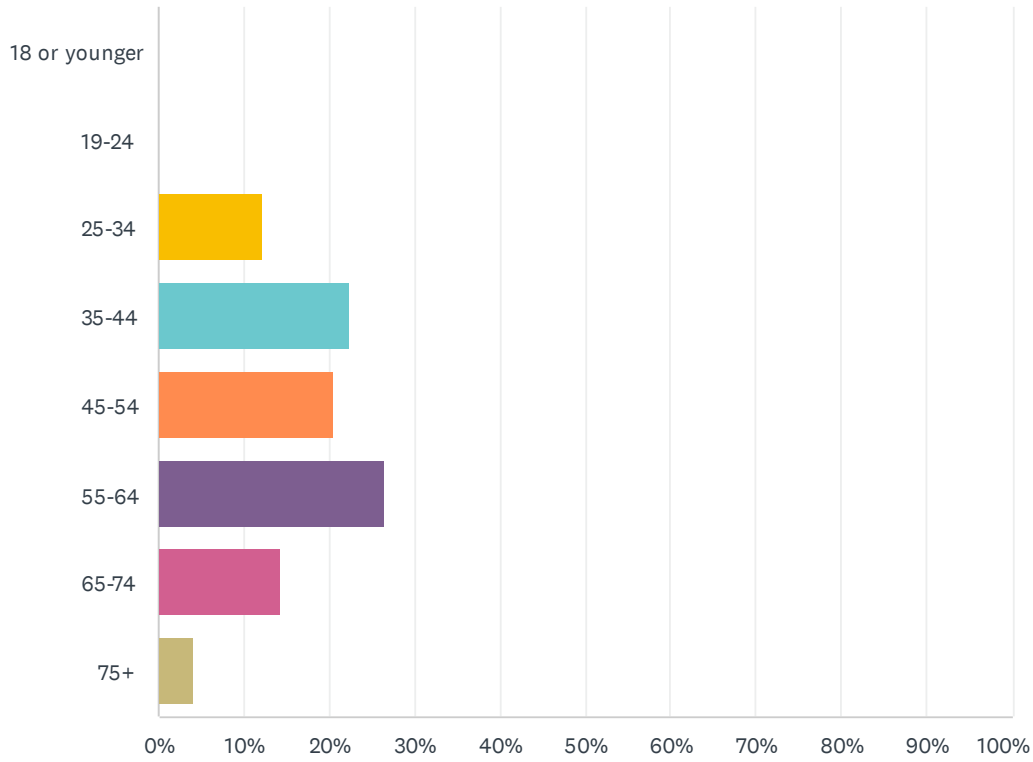

Q8 How old are you?

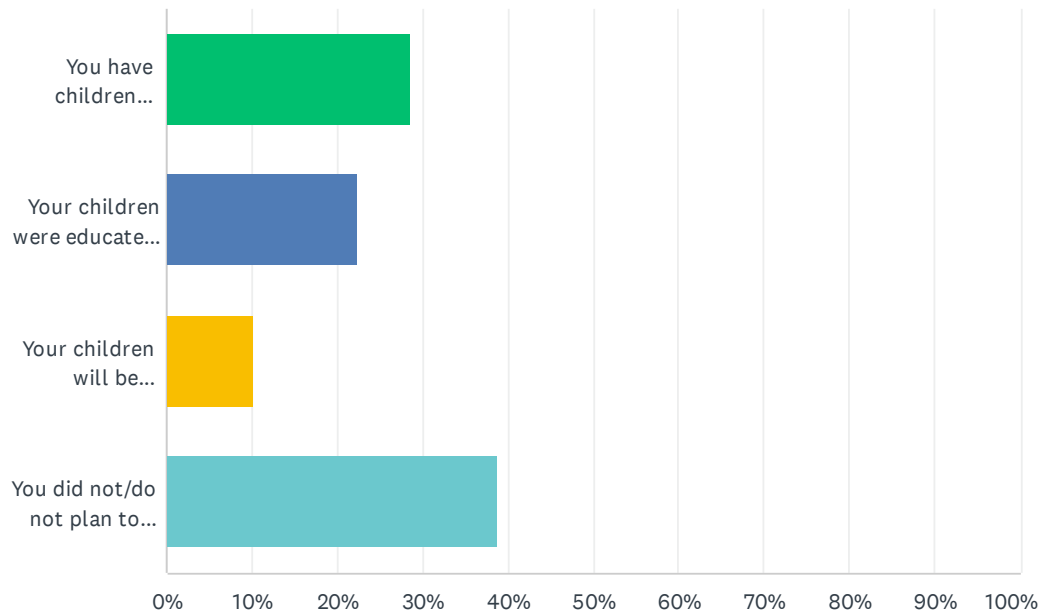

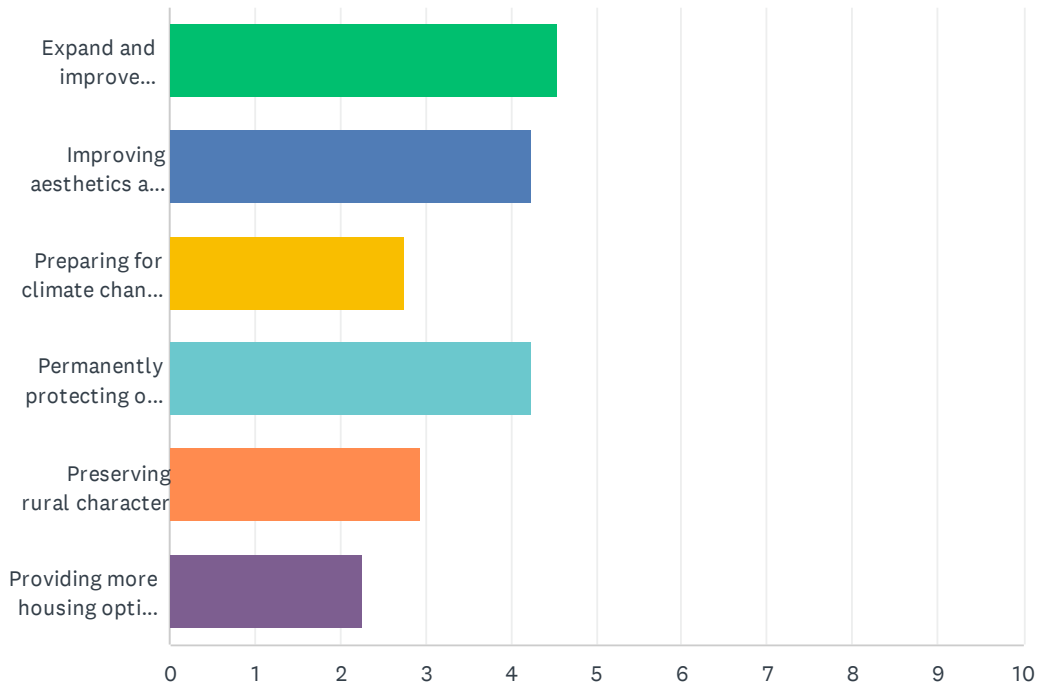

Q16 How should the Town prioritize the following planning issues related to development and land protection? Please rank each item below with the number 1 being most important and 6 being least important

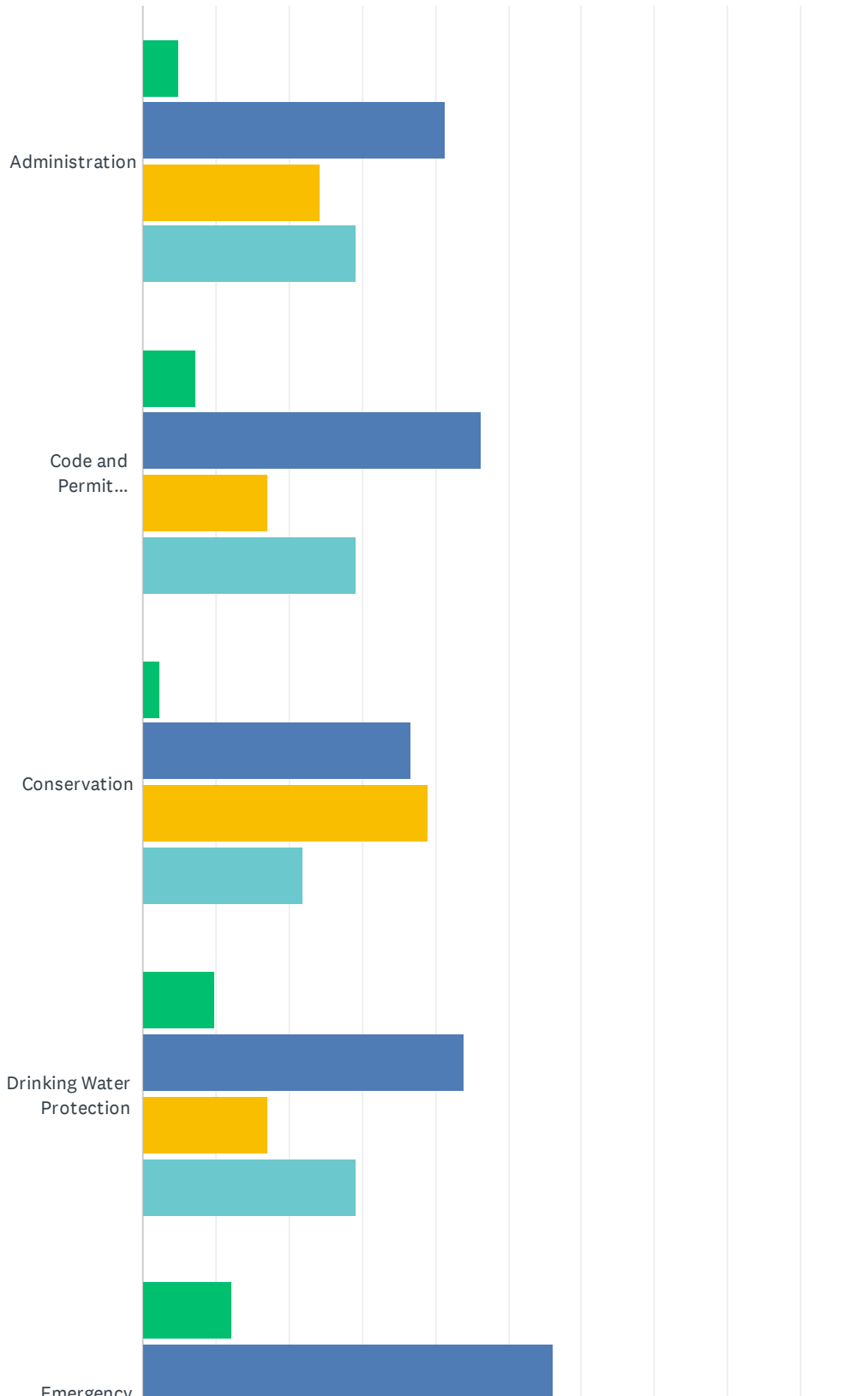
